When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent, on instructions, submitted that based on the complaint given by one K.V.Dass as against the petitioner, current paper enquiry has been conducted in C.No.G4/1628/124340/2025 and the same has been closed as early as on 12.01.2026 and the petitioner was called only for enquiry and that the respondent police are not harassing the petitioner.

3. Recording the above submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), this criminal original petition stands closed. It is made clear that the respondent-police shall not unnecessarily harass the petitioner.
