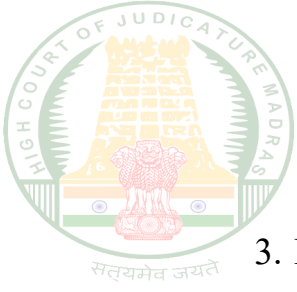

Order

(Order of the Court was made by Dr.Anita Sumanth J.)

Statutory notice was issued to the respondents 1 and 2 and they are present before this Court today. As far as the allegations against the respondents 3 and 4, there is no contempt committed by them and hence the contempt proceedings against them are closed.

2. As far as the respondents 1 and 2 are concerned, pursuant to the institution of Contempt Petition, it is stated that, they surveyed the subject land and sent a report to the Commissioner, Tambaram Municipality. With this, the Contempt Petition may be closed as regards the respondents 1 and 2 as well. Recording the same, this Contempt petition is closed.



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3. In the Order dated 16.04.2025 in W.P. No.13342 of 2025, there was a further direction for the Commissioner, Tambaram Municipality, to act on the report of the respondents 1 and 2. Though the Tambaram Municipality has not been arrayed in this Contempt Petition for the reason that the initial direction has not been complied with by the respondents 1 and 2, since the report has now been furnished by them, there is a time bound direction to the Commissioner, Tambaram Municipality (2nd respondent in the Writ Petition), to do the needful within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Let copy of this order be served on the Commissioner, Tambaram Municipality, by the petitioner for their necessary action.
