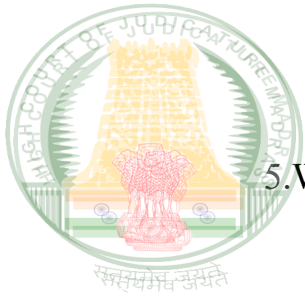
Order

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to provide adequate and effective police protection to the petitioner life and limb, including the deployment of two armed guards for petitioner and his family, based on his representation dated 04.12.2025.

2. According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 04.12.2025 requesting to provide adequate police protection but, the same is yet to be disposed of by the respondents. Hence, the petitioner is before this Court.
