This petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 136 days in filing the appeal.

2.In the affidavit filed in support of the petition, it had been stated that after obtaining the certified copy of the decree, steps were taken to file the appeal, but there was a delay in generating the Court fee.

3.Notice had been directed to the respondents. The learned counsel had entered appearance on behalf of the 3rd respondent. The 1st and 2nd respondents had remained *ex parte* even before the trial Court.
