ORDER

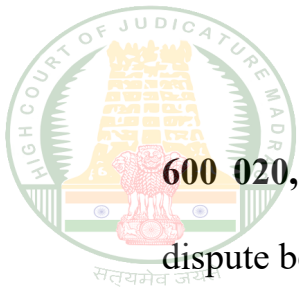
WEB COPY This Arbitration Original Petition has been filed under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, to adjudicate the disputes arising out of the Memorandum of understanding dated 31.07.2024 entered into between the petitioners and the Respondents.

2. Heard Mr.Anupam Raghuraman, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.M.S.Krishnan, learned Senior Counsel, for the respondent.

3. When the matter is taken up, the learned counsel for the respondents had also expressed his consent for appointment of Arbitrator.
