The writ petition has been filed seeking to quash the impugned order of the 5th respondent in Na.Ka.No.F1/P.R/No.42 of 2021 dated 17.12.2024, and to direct the respondents to reinstate the petitioner in the cadre of Special Sub Inspector of Police, with all service and other monetary benefits.

2. The case of the petitioner is that he joined the service as Grade II police in the year 1988 and had served in the Department for more than 33 years with unblemished records and is presently, holding the post of Special Sub Inspector of Police. According to the petitioner, a false case was foisted against him in Crime No.898 of 2020, on the file of Tiruppur Central Police Station, Tiruppur, which ended in departmental proceedings in P.R.No.42 of 2021. The petitioner would submit that during the departmental enquiry, the respondents had failed to consider the statement given by a key witness *inter alia* exonerating him from the crime, but had mechanically issued the impugned order dated 17.12.2024, imposing punishment of removal from service. Challenging the said order, the petitioner is before this Court.
