Heard Mr.Ismath Hajaram, for Mr.J.Titus Enock, learned counsel for the
Petitioner.

2. It appears that notice has been issued to the respondent by the Registry
in pursuant to the order dated 09.03.2026. As per the Office report dated
17.06.2026, the notice has already been served on the respondent.

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, there is no
representation on behalf of the respondent either in person or through his
