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2. Today when the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this Criminal Original Petition for the reason that he was unable to contact his client.

3. This Court had earlier passed orders in favour of the petitioner giving some protection. Now, the petitioner's attitude of not only cheating the respondent/complainant and also making false representation before this Court is clearly exposed. In view of the same, this Court is not inclined to entertain this petition. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed. The learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court at Magisterial Level, Ambattur, is directed to take immediate step to ensure the conviction warrant is executed without delay. It is made clear that at the time of execution of the conviction warrant, if the petitioner is willing to settle the dispute, the same may be considered by the learned trial Judge.
