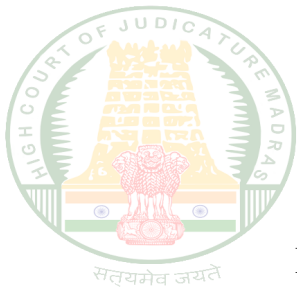

### **ORDER**
