WEB COPY This Criminal Original Petition has been filed, seeking a direction to the learned Judicial Magistrate II, Thiruvallur to expedite the trial in C.C.No.422 of 2023 in Crime No.38 of 2011 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate II, Thiruvallur.

2. On an earlier occasion i.e., on 11.03.2026, this Court passed the following direction:

“4. The Registrar (Judicial) shall get a report from the learned Judicial Magistrate-II, Thiruvallur with regard to the stage of the case, the reasons for the prolonged delay and the likely date on which the case will be taken up for trial and completed and place the same before this Court on 23.03.2026.”

This case was filed by CCD(AUGST) Aardh this one defacto complainant filed a complaint that the accused namely Prashap K. Monuri and Sarinendranath reddy executed a fraudulent sale deed in favour of Defacto Complainant on capacity as power agent of mrs Radha Krishna Giliary. The allegation is that the accused was already sold the very same plot to one Soveranum prior to this Defacto Complainant. Hence the case was registered and filed before special court of land grabbing. By an RDC No.934059/2022/DG4 dated 10.05.2023 and the proceedings of Hon'ble Principal district & Sessions court, Thiruvallur in D.No.337/2023 dated 18.05.2023 this Crl. No.29/2022 transferred to this Court and the same was re numbered as CC No.422/2023 dated 03.07.2023.

At the time of the transferring the above case the discharge petition filed by the 1st Accused was pending. For the 2nd Accused already questioned and charge has been framed. On 04.09.2024 the Defacto Complainant filed a petition and vakalat to assist the prosecution of the case. Through the 1st and 2nd Accused and Respondent not filed the answer and prolonged the matter this court Sub motu perused the bundle and on 15.06.2025 allowed the Petition. Now the discharge petition filed by the 1st Accused was posted for orders on 23.03.2026. After the disposal of the discharge petition immediately the trial will commence. As a junior Judge I took charge only on 29.12.2025 and taking the case expeditious as possible. Hence, I request your Lordship to grant time I will dispose of the case as earliest as possible.
