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PRAYER

Directing the 1st and 2nd Respondents to forthwith appoint a competent licensed Surveyor to conduct field measurement of the petitioners property comprised in Survey No.301/8 (formerly Survey No.301/7) Ward-C Tiruttani Town Panchayat, Tiruttani Taluk, Thiruvallur District, measuring an extent of 1320 Sq. ft. Strictly on the basis of the existing revenue records and consequently direct the 3rd Respondent -Inspector of Police, D1, Tiruttani



Police Station to provide necessary police protection and assistance during the conduct of survey so as to ensure peaceful and unobstructed measurement of the petitioner property

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the respondents 1 and 2 to survey and demarcate the property, which according to the petitioner is owned by him, based on his online application dated 28.01.2026 within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

2. The petitioner had submitted an online application on 28.01.2026 for the aforesaid purpose. Since the same has not been considered till date, the petitioner has filed this writ petition.

3. Mr. S.Arumugam, learned Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1 and 2. Mr. V. Meganathan, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) accepts notice on behalf of the third respondent.

4. This Court is not expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's representation.



5. No prejudice will be caused to the second respondent if the said authority is directed to survey and demarcate the boundaries of the petitioner's property, morefully described in the prayer to this writ petition, after hearing the objections if any from the neighbouring land owners as well as any other party whom they deem it fit. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of in the following manner:-

(a) Before surveying the lands in question, the second respondent is directed to issue notice to the neighbouring land owners and also to any other party, whom they deem it fit to enquire.

(b) After receiving objections if any and after considering the same, the second respondent shall conduct survey and demarcate the boundaries of the property, morefully described in the prayer to this writ petition, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

(c) If the need arises for police assistance and on a request made by the second respondent, the third respondent shall render police assistance for the effective implementation of this order.
