PRAYER: Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India praying to issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondents 2 and 3 to furnish allservice and monetary benefits of petitioner husband deceased M.Ramsingh which was granted by an order dated 10.6.2011 passed in WP No.1119 of 2008 on the file of this Honble court and also as per G.O.Ms.No.543 Health and family welfare(L1)Department dated 28.11.2025 within a stipulated period.

ORDER

The writ petition has been filed for the following relief:

“directing the respondents 2 and 3 to furnish all service and monetary benefits of petitioner husband deceased M.Ramsingh which was granted by an order dated 10.6.2011 passed in WP No.1119 of 2008 on the file of this Honble court and also as per G.O.Ms.No.543 Health and family welfare(L1)Department dated 28.11.2025 within a stipulated period.”

2. It is the case of the petitioner that her husband was appointed as Vaccinator on 01.07.1966. As he had completed the sanitary Inspector Course on 01.07.1977, he is eligible for promotion as a Health Inspector Grade I from 01.07.1977 itself. While so, her husband filed a writ petition in W.P.No.1119 of 2008 before this Court, seeking all attendant benefits and regularization with retrospective effect which was allowed on 10.06.2011.

2.1. Thereafter, her husband died on 19.08.2023 leaving the petitioner as legal heir and co pensioner. After filing several contempt petitions, the first respondent passed a government order in G.O.Ms.No.543 dated 28.11.2025, pursuant to which, the petitioner's husband is entitled to receive all service and



monetary benefits. After his death, the petitioner is entitled to receive all his monetary benefits. Hence, she sent representation dated 09.02.2026 to the respondents 2 and 3. Since there is no response till date, aggrieved petitioner is before this Court.

3. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.

4. A mere perusal of the records would clearly indicate the fact that the petitioner is entitled to receive her husband's benefits as per the government order G.O.Ms.No.543 dated 28.11.2025. Accordingly, this writ petition is allowed and the respondents are directed to disburse the amounts as per the orders passed in G.O.Ms.No.543 dated 28.11.2025 within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
