### **ORDER**

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to cancel the patta standing in the name of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent for the

property morefully disclosed in the affidavit filed in support of this writ petition, based on the petitioner's representation, dated 12.02.2026.

2. The petitioner had given a representation on 12.02.2026 to the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent for the aforesaid purpose. Since the same was not considered, the petitioner has filed this writ petition.

3. Mr.R.P.Murugan Raja, learned Government Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent. Since no adverse order is passed against the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in this writ petition, notice to the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent is dispensed with by this Court.

4. No prejudice would be caused to the respondents, if the petitioner's representation as stated supra is considered on merits and in accordance with, after hearing the objections of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and any other party, whom the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent deems it fit to enquire, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court. This Court is not expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's representation.

For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent to pass final orders, on merits and in accordance with law, on the petitioner's representation, dated 12.02.2026 seeking cancellation of patta standing in the name of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent for the property morefully disclosed in the affidavit filed in support of this writ petition, after giving due consideration to the supporting documents filed by the petitioner and after hearing the objections, if any, from the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent and any other party, whom the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent deems it fit to enquire, within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the aforesaid direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
