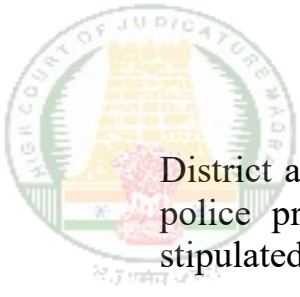

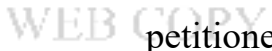

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the respondents 1 and 2 to survey and demarcate the property, which according to the petitioner is owned by him, based on his online application dated 12.12.2025 within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

2. The petitioner had submitted an online application on 12.12.2025 for the aforesaid purpose. Since the same has not been considered till date, the petitioner has filed this writ petition.

3. Mr. C. Jayaprakash, learned Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1 and 2. Mr. V. Meganathan, learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) accepts notice on behalf of the third respondent. Since no adverse orders are passed against the respondents 4 to 15, notice to the respondents 4 to 15 is dispensed with by this Court.



5. No prejudice will be caused to the respondents 1 and 2 if the said authorities are directed to survey and demarcate the boundaries of the petitioner's property, morefully described in the prayer to this writ petition, after hearing the objections of the respondents 4 to 15 and any neighbouring land owners as well as any other third party, whom they deem it fit to enquire.

(a) Before surveying the lands in question, the respondents 1 and 2 are directed to issue notice to the respondents 4 to 15 and any neighbouring land owners as well as any other third party, whom they deem it fit to enquire.

(c) If the need arises for police assistance and on a request made by the respondents 1 and 2, the third respondent



shall render police assistance for the effective implementation
of this order.
