ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed for the following reliefs:-

"directing the Respondents to disburse interest at the rate of 6 percent per annum for the belated payment of the Provident Fund, Gratuity, Pension Commutation and Earned leave Surrender within the such time as may be stipulated by this Honble Court."

2. The case of the petitioner is that he was appointed as a Conductor in the 1st respondent Transport Corporation and, after rendering several years of service, retired on attaining the age of superannuation on 30.06.2024. However, the terminal benefits have been settled to the petitioner only on 02.12.2025 and no interest has been paid for the delayed period. Therefore, the petitioner had submitted a representation to the respondents dated 16.12.2026, to pay interest for the delayed period. Since the same was not considered, the present writ petition has been filed.



3. The learned Standing Counsel for the respondents 1 and 2 would fairly submit that they are willing to pay the interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the belated payment of the eligible and admissible amount.

4. Heard the learned counsel for both sides and perused the materials available on record.

5. In view of the above submission of the learned Standing Counsel, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondents to pay interest at the rate of 6% per annum for the belated payment of admissible terminal benefits from the date of retirement till the date of actual disbursement of the terminal benefits of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
