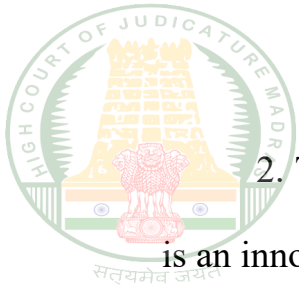

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 316(2), 318(4) and 351(3) of B.N.S.S., 2023 in Crime No.Not known of of 2026, seeks anticipatory bail.



2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person.

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3. At this juncture, the learned Government Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondent Police would submit that the formal arrest of the petitioner has been taken place on 17.04.2026 and investigation is pending.

4. Hence, considering the above circumstances, this Court is of the view that if the petitioner is enlarged on bail there is every possibility of tampering the witness. Hence, all the Criminal Original Petitions stand dismissed.
