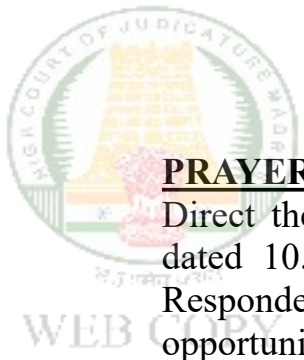

ORDER
