## **ORDER**

For the foregoing reasons, this Writ Petition is disposed of, by directing the respondent to pass final orders on merits and in accordance with law, on the petitioner's online application dated 18.11.2025, seeking for grant of separate Patta in his name for the property more fully disclosed in the prayer of this Writ Petition, after giving due consideration to the supporting documents produced by the petitioner and after hearing all the necessary parties, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
