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2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) strongly opposed this petition on the ground that the petitioner has not all comply with the conditions imposed. However, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that though the petitioner has visiting the police station, the authorities refused to give the note.
