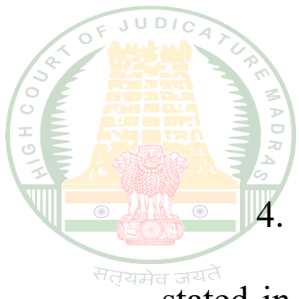
(i) Copy of the complaint dated 25.09.2019 given by P.W.1 to the Respondent against Petitioner;

2. Heard the learned counsel for the Petitioner/Appellant and the learned Public Prosecutor (Criminal Side) appearing for the Respondent.

3. The learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the Respondent submitted that the aforesaid documents were available during the trial. However, the same were not marked as exhibits before the Trial Court. He further submitted that the petition seeking permission to mark the said documents as additional evidence may be allowed.



4. Considering the submissions made on either side, and the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, this Court is inclined to allow the petition and receive the aforesaid documents as additional evidence in order to afford a fair opportunity to the Petitioner/Appellant.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is allowed as prayed for.
