4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents would submit that the 2nd respondent Police shall file a final report within a period of three months.

5. In view of the above submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the 2nd respondent police is directed to either file a final report or closure report, as the case may be, within a period of three months

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from the date of receipt of a copy of this order under due intimation to the de
facto complainant.

6. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed
of.
