It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner got admission for the course of B.A., LLB (Hons) and due to some love affair and picking up of quarrel, it is alleged that the petitioner was not permitted to rejoin the respondent college and it is the grievance of the petitioner that the petitioner had paid semester fees and other fees, however, the petitioner was not permitted. In this regard, the petitioner made a representation on 29.12.2025, however, the same is pending without consideration. Hence, this writ petition.

4. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the materials placed on record. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court without going into the merits of the case directs the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 29.12.2025 and pass appropriate order on merits and in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this Order.

5. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
