ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking for a limited relief. The petitioner seeks for an early disposal of his appeal, dated 13.08.2025, pending on the file of the 1st respondent.

2. Aggrieved by the order of the 2nd respondent, dated 18.07.2025, the aforesaid appeal, dated 13.08.2025 has been filed by the petitioner before the 1st respondent.

3. Mr.C.Jayaprakash, learned Government Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1 to 3. Since no adverse order is passed against the 4th respondent in this writ petition, notice to the 4th respondent is dispensed with by this Court.

4. No prejudice would be caused to the respondents, if a direction is issued to the 1st respondent to dispose of the petitioner's appeal dated



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13.08.2025 on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the objections of the 4th respondent, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court, by adhering to the principles of natural justice. This Court is not expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's appeal.

5. For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the 1st respondent to dispose of the petitioner's appeal, dated 13.08.2025 on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after hearing the objections of the 4th respondent and by adhering to the principles of natural justice.

6. With the aforesaid direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
