ORDER

This writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks a direction to the first respondent to proceed with the enrolment process without any further delay, subject to the reversal upon any adverse report from the third respondent, and to direct the third respondent to take this matter with utmost priority and complete the process of verification at the earliest.

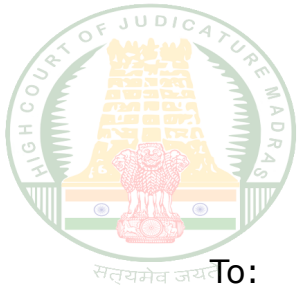
