Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, to relax the condition in paragraph No.9(ii) imposed upon the petitioner in Crl.A.No.140 of 2026 dated 19.02.2026 that he should reside at Chennai and report before the Royapettah Police Station, every day at 10.30 a.m., until further orders, except on the hearing dates before the trial Court.



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ORDER

WEB COPY This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking relaxation of condition at paragraph 9 (ii) imposed by this Court vide order dated 19.02.2026 in Crl.A.No.140 of 2026.

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant that this Court, while allowing the appeal in Crl.A.No.140 of 2026, vide order dated 19.02.2026, imposed a condition directing the petitioner/appellant to reside at Chennai and report before the Royapettah Police Station, everyday at 10.30 a.m., except on the hearing dates before the trial Court. It is further submitted that the petitioner/appellant has been complying with the said condition from 19.02.2026 without fail and that he is the sole breadwinner of his family. It is also submitted that the petitioner is working as a Junior Engineer in a private company and he is not able to go for his work. Hence, he prayed to relax the said condition.

3. Learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the petitioner/appellant has been regularly complying with the conditions imposed by this Court and now the case has



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been taken up by the trial Court and posted to 28.04.2026 for appearance of the accused.

4. Having heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and upon perusal of the materials available on record and also taking note of the reasons adduced in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, this Court is inclined to modify the condition at paragraph 9 (ii) imposed by this Court.

5. Accordingly, the condition at paragraph 9(ii) imposed by this Court in Crl.A.No.140 of 2026 vide order dated 19.02.2026 is modified to the effect that **the petitioner/appellant shall appear before the trial Court on 28.04.2026 at 10.30 a.m., and thereafter, on the date(s) fixed by the learned trial Judge.**

6. With the above modification, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition stands disposed of.
