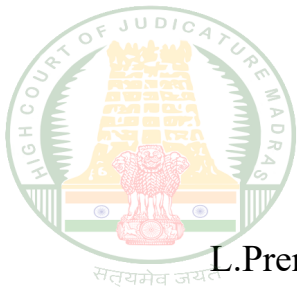

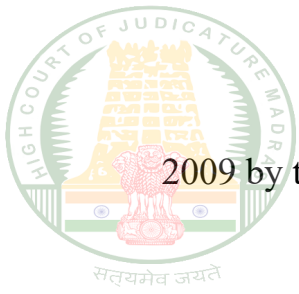

ORDER
