ORDER

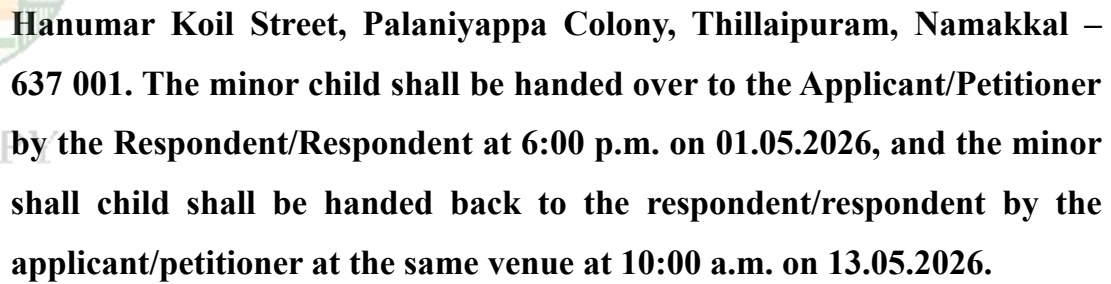
This application has been filed to grant temporary custody of the minor child Mahiz Isai Nithyavendhan to the Applicant, Nithyavendhan K, for the period 01/05/2026 to 30/05/2026, being summer vacation period.

2. Both the learned counsels for the petitioner and the respondent submit that the parties have filed a Joint Memo, dated 29.04.2026 duly signed by both the parties and their respective counsels and the same is extracted as below:-

“ The Applicant/Petitioner and the respondent/respondent jointly submit the following:

1. The parties humbly submit that upon deliberations they have arrived at the following mutually agreed arrangement for the month of May 2026, purely as a temporary and special arrangement for the summer vacation period, without prejudice to their rights, contentions, and reliefs raised/made in O.P.No.403 of 2025, G.W.O.P.No.77 of 2025, O.S.A.Sr.No.191820 of 2025, and OSA.No.360 of 2025. The parties further agree that nothing contained herein shall be construed as an admission, concession or waiver by either party in respect of any issue arising in the said proceedings.
