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ORDER

The present Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.2357 of 2021, on the file of the Metropolitan Magistrate, Fast Track Court – II, Chennai.

2. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record.

3. Learned counsel appearing on either side submitted that when the matter was taken up on 28.02.2025, this Court referred the matter to mediation. Pursuant thereto, the parties appeared before the Tamil Nadu Mediation & Conciliation Centre, wherein, they have compromised the matter and amicably settled the issue between themselves. A Joint Compromise Memo to that effect has also been filed. Hence, they seek to quash the proceedings pending against the petitioner.

The Petitioner and Respondent humbly submits that, the Respondent/Complainant filed complaint under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, for dishonour of Cheque for a sum of Rs 30,05,893/- dated 28.11.2019. The Cheque was dishonoured as "Stop Payment" and the Respondent issued Legal Notice and filed the Private Complaint in C.C.No.2537 of 2021 on the file of Fast Track Court-II, Metropolitan Magistrate, Allikulam, Chennai.
2. The Petitioner and Respondent humbly submits that, the Petitioner filed the above Quash Petition before this Hon'ble Court. During the pendency of this Petition, the case was transferred from Fast Track Court-II, Metropolitan Magistrate, Allikulam, Chennai to XXV-Metropolitan Magistrate Court, Egmore, Chennai.

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3. The Petitioner and Respondent humbly submits that, during the pendency of the Quash Petition, the Petitioner paid a sum of Rs.23,00,000/- to the Respondent on various dates by way of bank transfer. There was an outstanding of Rs.7,05,895/- payable to the Respondent.
4. The Petitioner and Respondent humbly submits that, under these circumstances, on 28.02.2025 this Hon'ble Court referred the above matter to the Mediation Centre. Both the parties appeared before the Mediation Centre and arrived at an amicable settlement. After negotiations, the Respondent agreed to receive a sum of Rs.5,50,000/- as full and final settlement of its dues.
5. The Petitioner submits that, the Petitioner handed over Demand Draft bearing No.168014 for a sum of Rs.5,50,000/- dated 02.04.2025, drawn on The Karur Vysya Bank Limited, Vellappan Chavadi Branch, Chennai, in favour of the Respondent.
6. The Respondent submits that, on 09.04.2025 at the Mediation Centre, the Respondent/Complainant received the Demand Draft for Rs.5,50,000/- as full and final settlement of its dues. There was no outstanding between the Petitioner and the Respondent.
7. The Respondent submits that, the Respondent have no objection to allow the present Quash Petition to quash C.C.No.2537 of 2021 on the file of XXV-Metropolitan Magistrate, Egmore, Chennai.
8. This Joint Compromise Memo entered between the Petitioner and the Respondent were executed voluntarily, on their own and with mutual consent without any fear, pressure, force, fraud, under influence and coercion.

The Petitioner and the Respondent prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to accept the Joint Compromise Memo and quash the Proceedings.
