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ORDER

This Court is not expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's appeal.

4. For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the 1st respondent to dispose of the petitioner's appeal, dated 02.02.2026 on merits and in



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accordance with law, within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after hearing the objections of the 3rd respondent and by adhering to the principles of natural justice.

5. With the aforesaid direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
