ORDER

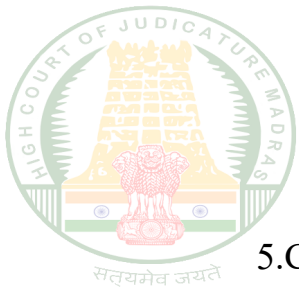
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This writ petition has been filed seeking to direct the respondents to pass order on the petitioner's representation dated 25.02.2026 and to issue separate patta for petitioner's property comprised in Survey No.20/2A, 17/223/17A,23/18 total to the extent of 0.38 1/2 cents in Arangam Village, Yercaud Taluk, Salem District.

2.Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner made a representation dated 25.02.2026 seeking for an issuance of separate patta in his favour for the property comprised in Survey No.20/2A, 17/223/17A,23/18 total to the extent of 0.38 1/2 cents in Arangam Village, Yercaud Taluk, Salem District. However, the said representation was not considered by the respondents. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3.Mr.M.Guruprasad, learned Government's Counsel, who accepts notice on behalf of the respondents would submit that the petitioner's representation dated 25.02.2026 will be considered and disposed of within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

4.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Government's Counsel appearing for the respondents.

Considering the submission made by both parties and in view of the limited prayer sought for in this writ petition, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, directs the 3rd respondent to dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 25.02.2026, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
