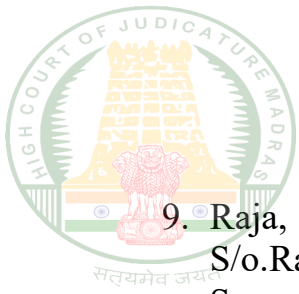

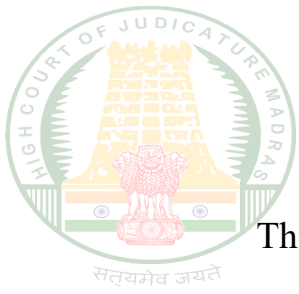

**ORDER**

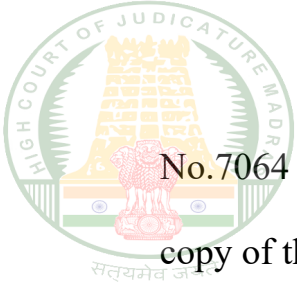
This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 02.02.2026.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in this case, the petitioner has given a representation dated 02.02.2026 to disburse the statutory entitlement namely 30% solatium with interest till the day of payment, in the light of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of Union of India and another Vs Tarsem Singh and others, in Civil Appeal No.7064 of 2019. Since the same has not been considered, the present writ petition is filed.

No.7064 of 2019, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

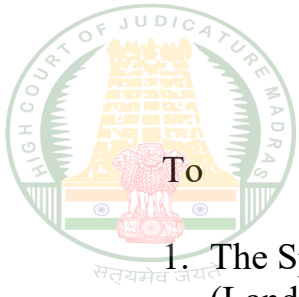
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6. With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
