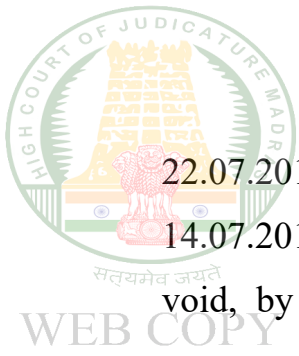

Prayer: This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 1 to 3 to cancel the Deeds in Doc.No.7852/2009 dated 26.10.2009, Doc.No.7442/2010 dated



22.07.2010, Doc.No.14105/2015 dated 02.11.2015, 8224/2016 dated 14.07.2016, and Doc. No.5718/2017 dated 12.07.2017 at SRO Avadi as null and void, by considering the Petitioners' representation dated 14.03.2026.

ORDER

This writ petition is filed to direct the respondents to consider the petitioners' representation dated 14.03.2026.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners have made a representation dated 14.03.2026 before the respondents 1 to 3 to cancel the sale deeds in Doc.No.7852/2009 dated 26.10.2009, Doc.No.7442/2010 dated 22.07.2010, Doc.No.14105/2015 dated 02.11.2015, 8224/2016 dated 14.07.2016, and Doc. No.5718/2017 dated 12.07.2017 at SRO Avadi as null and void. However, till date, the said representation was not considered. Hence, this writ petition.

3. Mr.Roshan Atiq M., learned Government's Counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondents 1 to 3 and submitted that the official respondents have no power to cancel the sale deeds, as the Hon'be Division Bench of this Court in the case of *M.Kathirvel Vs., Inspector General of Registration, Department of*



Registration and Others, reported in 2024 SCC Online Mad 6154 has struck down Sections 77A and 68(2) of the Registration Act. Hence, the right course available to the petitioners is to file a civil suit before the appropriate forum.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.

5. Recording the submission made by the learned Government's Counsel appearing for the respondents 1 to 3, this writ petition is dismissed with liberty to file a civil suit before the Civil Court in the manner known to law. No costs.
