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JUDGMENT

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This Second Appeal is filed against the judgment and decree dated 22.01.2019 made in A.S. No.10 of 2016 passed by the learned Principal District Judge, Namakkal, confirming the judgment and decree dated 18.12.2015 made in O.S. No.64 of 2014 passed by the learned Subordinate Judge, Rasipuram.



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2. With the consent of both the parties the matter was referred to the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Madras, for arriving at an amicable settlement between the parties. Accordingly settlement was arrived at between the parties and a Mediation Report of the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Madras, along with the Settlement Agreement dated 17.11.2025 entered into between the parties, duly signed by both the appellant and the respondent and their counsel, is filed and the same is recorded and scanned hereunder:



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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

This **SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT** entered into on this the 17th day of November 2025

S.GANESAN, Son of Sengoda gounder, residing at Kollikataiyar Mill Kadu, Oduvankurichi Post, Rasipuram Taluk, Namakkal District

AND

P.Chinnadurai, Son of K.Perianna gounder, residing at EX.CAD Thottam, Oduvankurichi Post, Rasipuram Taluk, Namakkal District

WHEREAS

1. Disputes and difference had arisen between the parties hereto and S.A.No. 209/2023 was filed on 03.06.2019 before Hon'ble High Court.
2. The matter was referred to mediation/ conciliation vide an order dated 17.09.2025 passed by Justice Mrs. Govindarajan Thilakavadi.
3. The parties agreed that S.S.Jothivani would act as their Mediator/ Conciliator.
4. Several meetings were held during the process of Mediation/ Conciliation from 10.10.2025 to 17.11.2025 and the parties have with the assistance of Mediator/ Conciliator voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above mentioned disputes and differences.
5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and of their own free will arrived at this



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Settlement Agreement in the presence of the Mediator/
Conciliator.

6. The following settlement has been arrived at between the parties hereto

(A) The total claim of the suit is Rs.7,62,000/- and parties agreed for a settlement of Rs.6,00,000/-

(B) The appellant has transferred a sum of RS.6,00,000/- towards full and final settlement through RTGS, in respect of the above claim on 17.11.2025.

(C) The respondent / plaintiff has acknowledged the above sum and has no further claim towards principal or interest in the future.

7. By signing this Agreement the Parties hereto state that they have no further claims or demands against each other with respect to S.A.No.209/2023 and all disputes and differences in this regard have been amicably settled by the Parties hereto through the process of conciliation/ Mediation.
