Prayer: Writ petition is filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to consider the petitioners representation application dated 07.04.2026 and to conduct survey in the patta property of the petitioner in Madhavaram Village, Chelliayamman Nagar, Survey No. 437/2A, T.S.No. 15/12, Block No.5, Ward -B, Madhavaram Taluk, Greater Chennai Corporation, measuring an Extent of 844 Sq.ft of vacant Housing land out of 4454 Sq.ft., of land and to measure the proper boundaries and proper measurements so as to enable the petitioner to enjoy the patta land by the petitioner with peaceful possession and to pass orders on the representation within the stipulated period.

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ORDER

The petition has been filed seeking a direction to respondent to conduct survey of the property of the petitioner situated in Survey No. 437/2A, T.S.No. 15/12, Block No.5, Ward -B, Madhavaram Taluk, Greater Chennai Corporation.

2. It is the case of the petitioner that the subject property was purchased by him from one C.Aswini and he also got patta for the same in his name. The petitioner submitted a representation on 07.04.2026 seeking survey of the property purchased by him and the same has not been considered by the 2nd respondent. Hence, he has come before this Court.

3. Mr.P.Balathandayutham, learned Special Government Pleader, who takes notice for the respondent, submitted that petitioner has not submitted any online application seeking survey of the property. Hence, his request cannot be considered.

4. In view of the same, the petitioner is directed to submit proper online application together with necessary fees within a period of one week from the date of receipt of copy of this order. On submission of online application and payment of necessary fees by the petitioner, the 2nd respondent shall consider the same and pass final orders in accordance with the law within a further period of four weeks.



5. With this direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
