ORDER

Petition seeking bail in respect of Crime No.92 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 115(2), 190, 351(3), 308(4), 127(2) and 61(2) of the BNS r/w Section 4 of the TN Prohibition of Charging Exorbitant Interest Act, 2003, is on board for consideration.



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2. The learned counsel for the petitioner, pleading innocence on the part of the petitioner, who has been in incarceration since 12.03.2026 and false implication in the case, seeks indulgence of this Court. He also submits that though the petitioner is in no way connected with the alleged offence, due to previous enmity, he was implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this court.

3. The case of the prosecution as put forth by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police, while opposing the grant of bail, is that the accused had committed the offence of extortion and charged exorbitant interest from the *de facto* complainant, in violation of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Charging Exorbitant Interest Act, 2003. He further submits that the investigation in this case is still pending. He also submits that there is no previous case against the petitioner.

4. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent police and perused the materials available on record and considering the period of incarceration



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undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions and accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate No.II, Tirupattur**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] **the petitioner shall report before the respondent police, everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;**

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]***;



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[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
