Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to conduct an enquiry and pass final order by taking note of the communication issued by the 1st respondent vide Oo.Mu.COLREV-COLR/11495/2025-B3 dated 28.03.2025 by considering the written representation made by the petitioner on 17.03.2025 within a stipulated time as this Court may deem fit and proper.

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking for a limited relief. The petitioner seeks for an early disposal of his representation, dated 17.03.2025, seeking cancellation of the patta standing in the name of the respondents 4 and 5 for the property morefully disclosed in the affidavit filed in support of this writ petition.

2. Mr.C.Jayaprakash, learned Government Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1 to 3. Since no adverse orders are passed against the respondents 4 and 5 in this writ petition, notice to the respondents 4 and 5 is dispensed with by this Court.

3. Even though proceedings has been initiated by the 2nd respondent pursuant to the petitioner's representation, till date, no final order has been passed by the 2nd respondent on the petitioner's representation. Hence, the petitioner has filed this writ petition.



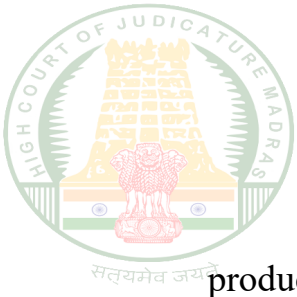
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4. No prejudice would be caused to the respondents, if the petitioner's representation as stated supra is directed to be disposed of by the 2nd respondent, on merits and in accordance with law, after giving due consideration to the supporting documents produced by the petitioner, and after hearing the objections of the respondents 4 and 5 and any other party, whom the 2nd respondent deems it fit to enquire, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court, by adhering to the principles of natural justice.

5. This Court is not expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's representation, dated 17.03.2025.

6. For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the 2nd respondent to pass final orders on merits and in accordance with law, on the petitioner's representation, dated 17.03.2025 seeking cancellation of the patta standing in the name of the respondents 4 and 5 in respect of the property morefully disclosed in the affidavit filed in support of this writ petition, after giving due consideration to the supporting documents



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produced by the petitioner, and after hearing the objections, if any, from the respondents 4 and 5 and any other party, whom the 2nd respondent deems it fit to enquire, within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
