ORDER

This writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's application dated 24.11.2025.

5. In reply, the learned Government's counsel appearing for the respondents would submit that based on the petitioner's representation, summons were issued to all the concerned parties and the date was also fixed

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6. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondents and also perused the entire materials available on record.

In the case on hand, today, it was submitted by the respondents that based on the application filed by the petitioner, summons were issued to all the concerned parties and the date for conducting survey was also fixed by the respondent. 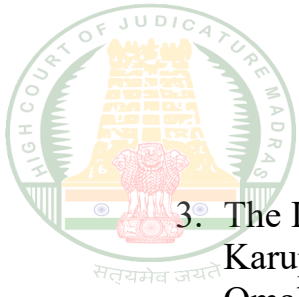
