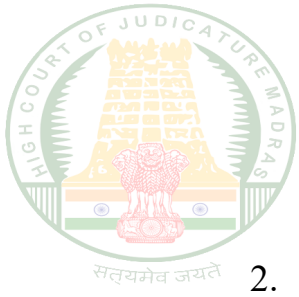

ORDER

Petition seeking bail in respect of Crime No.92 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 123 and 286 of BNS r/w Section 24(1) of the COTPA, 2003, is on board for consideration.

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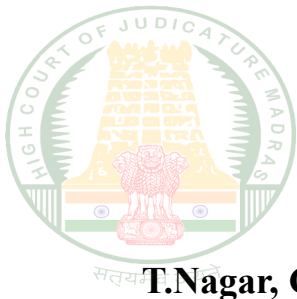

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2. The learned counsel for the petitioner/A3, pleading innocence on the part of the petitioner, who has been in incarceration since 26.03.2026 and false implication in the case, seeks indulgence of this Court. He also submits that the petitioner, without prejudice to the defence and contention, is ready and willing to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- to any welfare scheme of the Government or any other organization. He also submits that the similarly placed co-accused has been enlarged on bail by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.10698 of 2026 vide order dated 28.04.2026 and that the petitioner, is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court.

3. The case of the prosecution as put forth by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police, opposing the grant of bail, is that the accused were found to be in illegal possession of 11 kilograms of banned tobacco products. He further submits that two previous cases of similar nature are pending against the petitioner.

4. Considering the voluntary submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)** to the credit of "Charu Home for Aged, Account Number: **2771201000291, IFSC Code: CNRB0002771, Canara Bank, Mahila Br.,**

T.Nagar, Chennai – 17", without prejudice to the right of defence before the trial Court and making it clear that it would not amount to admission of guilt.

5. Further, having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the respondent police and perused the materials available on record, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions and accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum, to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate No.II, Tiruppur**, and on further conditions that:

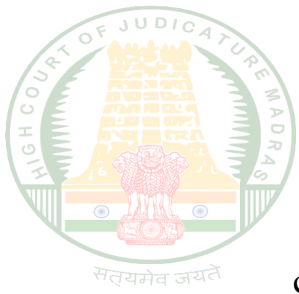
[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police, everyday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the

conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]*;

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
