The case of the petitioners is that they submitted a representation dated 09.09.2024 to the respondents, seeking regularization of their services with effect from their respective dates of initial appointment to enable them to receive family pension, along with all consequential service and monetary benefits. However, the said representation has not been disposed of by the



respondents till date. Aggrieved by this inaction, the petitioners have filed the present Writ Petition.

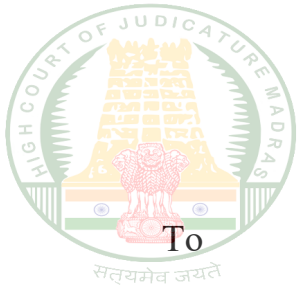
3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents.
