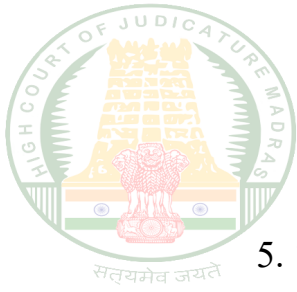
ORDER

An order dated 02.12.2025 is assailed in this writ petition on the ground of alleged breach of principles of natural justice.

2. Ms. Amirta Poonkodi Dinakaran, learned Government Counsel (Tax), accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Rs.1,00,498/- was recovered from the electronic liability ledger of the petitioner. Subject to adjustments thereof against the tax dues, he submits that the petitioner would pay 25% of the tax demand in the aggregate.

4. Subject to the petitioner remitting an additional amount towards the disputed tax demand, as agreed to so as to remit 25% in the aggregate after giving credit to sums recovered earlier, the impugned order is set aside. Consequently, the matter is remanded for re-consideration. After providing a reasonable opportunity to the petitioner, a fresh order shall be issued within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



5. The writ petition is disposed of on the above terms without any order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
