ORDER

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3.Heard the learned counsel on either side and carefully perused the materials available on record.

4.In view of the submissions made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the petitioners are directed to lodge a fresh complaint before the 1st respondent. Upon receipt of such complaint, the 1st respondent is directed to take necessary action in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.Accordingly, this Writ Petition (Criminal) stands disposed of. No costs.
