2. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

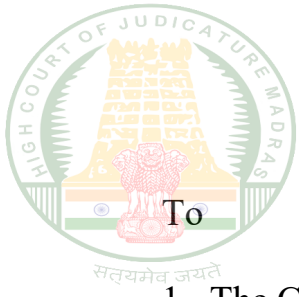
