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2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the petitioner has been complying with the condition regularly.

Considering the submissions made on either sides and the nature of the offence, this Court is inclined to modify the condition imposed in Para 10(c) of the common order dated 12.03.2026 in Crl.O.P.Nos.6366 and 6364 of 2026. Accordingly, the condition that “the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police daily at 10.30.a.m and 5.30 p.m., until further orders” is modified to the effect that ***“the petitioner shall report before the respondent Police on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders”***. The other conditions imposed earlier shall remain unaltered.

4. Accordingly, these criminal miscellaneous petitions are ordered.
