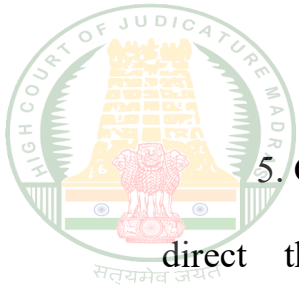
ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the learned Sessions Judge, Special Court for SC/ST Act, Tiruvannamalai to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider their bail application on the same day on merits in relating to Crime No.81 of 2026 on the file of the respondent police.

2. Considering the nature of the relief sought for, notice to the 3rd respondent is dispensed with.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner abused him by making caste-related remarks. Based on these allegations, an FIR has been registered against the petitioner.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and carefully perused the materials available on record.



5. Considering the limited scope of the relief sought for, this Court hereby direct the learned Sessions Judge, Special Court for SC/ST Act, Tiruvannamalai, to issue prior notice to the *de facto* complainant and thereafter, to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day of his surrender before that Court in connection with Crime No.81 of 2026 on the file of the 2nd respondent police. The petitioner shall surrender before the learned Trial Court within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
