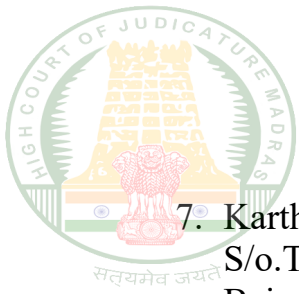

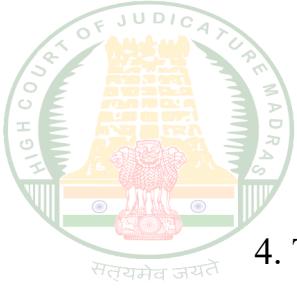
ORDER

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the State and perused the materials available on record.

3. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the fifth respondent is directed to issue notice to the petitioner as well as to respondents 6 to 9. After affording an opportunity of hearing to all the parties concerned, the fifth respondent shall pass appropriate orders on the petitioner's representation, if it is found feasible, within a period of **three (3) weeks** from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, if petitioner's representation is found feasible.
