ORDER

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This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to direct the Learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Ariyalur (Special Court for SC/ST cases, Ariyalur) to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day on merits in accordance with law of their surrender in connection with Crime No.228 of 2026 on the file of the respondent.

2. Considering the nature of the relief sought for, notice to the 3rd respondent is dispensed with.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners abused the defacto complainant using caste-based words, attacked him thereby causing injuries and threatened him. Based on these allegations, an FIR has been registered against the petitioners.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and carefully perused the materials available on record.

5. Considering the limited scope of the relief sought for, this Court hereby direct the learned Judge, Special Court for SC/ST, Ariyalur District to issue prior notice to the *de facto* complainant and thereafter, to consider the bail



application of the petitioner on the same day of his surrender before that Court in connection with Crime No.228 of 2026 on the file of the 2nd respondent police. The petitioner shall surrender before the learned Trial Court within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
