Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submission made on either side, this Court, without going into the merits of the case, directs the first respondent / Executive Engineer, to consider the petitioner's representation dated 06.04.2026 and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of three (3) weeks from today.

4. With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
