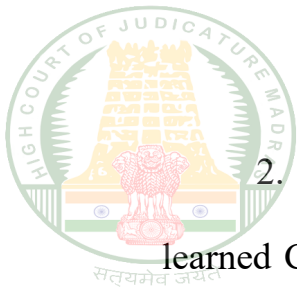

3. It is seen from the records that the petitioner has lodged a complaint before the fourth respondent on 13.04.2026 and the same is still pending without any progress.

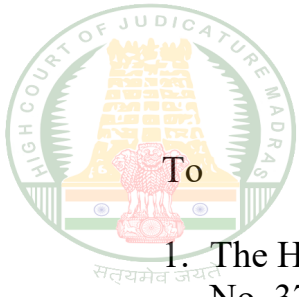
