2.When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents, submitted that the Government has issued Government Order in G.O.Ms.No.61, Labour Welfare and Skill Development (K2), dated 02.06.2022, permitting the shops and establishments to keep open for 24 x 7 on all days of the year; subject to complying with the conditions therein. He further submitted that the representation of the petitioner dated 07.05.2026, will be considered in the light of the above said Government Order and appropriate orders will be passed within a period of six (6) weeks.

this Writ Petition is disposed of.
