Heard, Mr.Karthik Lakshmanan AR., the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr.L.S.M.Hassan Fizal, the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 3. Issuance of notice, to the respondents 4 and 5, is dispensed with.

2. The petitioners have preferred an appeal before the second respondent questioning the issuance of patta in favour of the private respondents herein. The petitioners state that the private respondents are presently promoting the property by fraudulently including a road portion. For this reason, they seek a direction to the second respondent to dispose of their appeal. Therefore, I direct the second respondent to dispose of the petitioners' appeal on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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3. This Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
